CLASS 2

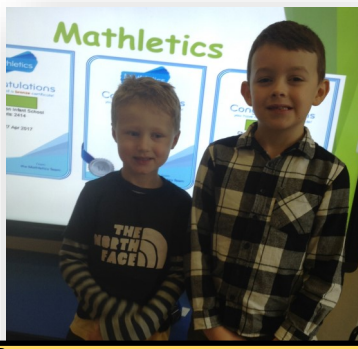
