Some wonderful work on time being sent in, well done everyone.



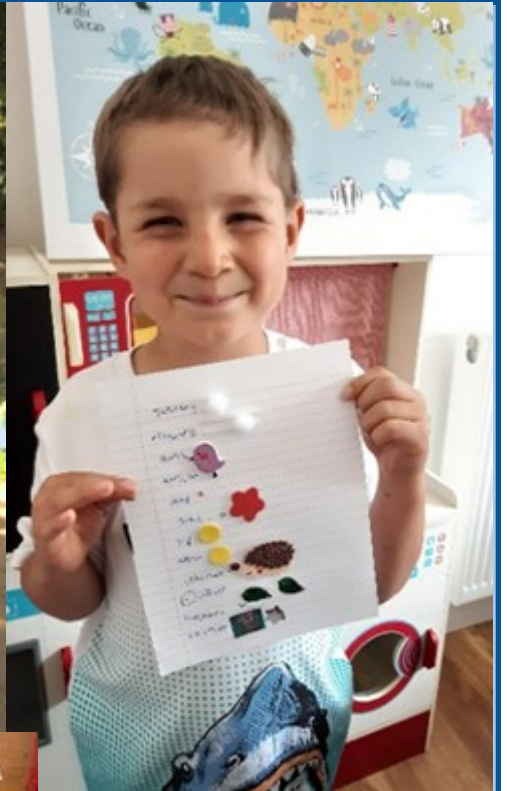

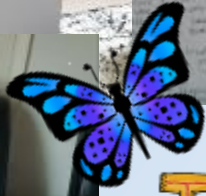
