INVOICES

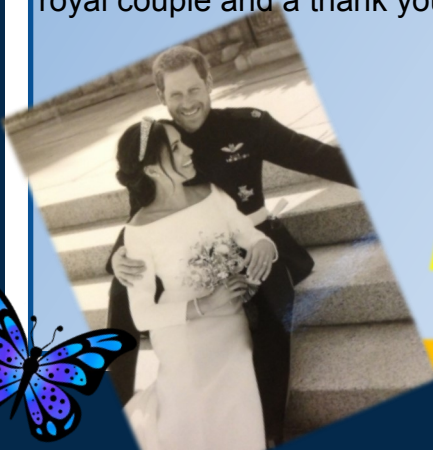
Autumn invoices including those for December clubs will be sent home early next week.
