Look who's celebrating his birthday this week.



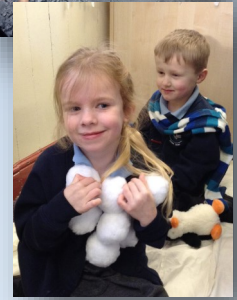


CLASS 1

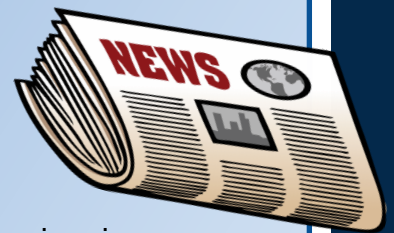
