FREE CYCLE COACHING FROM THE “BBC WEST MIDLANDS COMMUNITY SPORTS CLUB OF THE YEAR”!

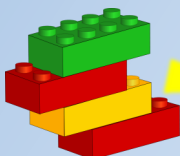
