CLASS 2

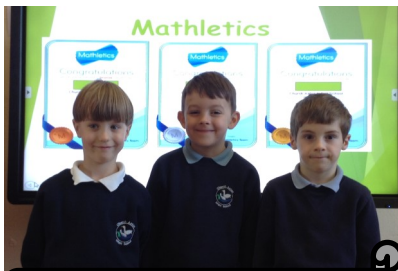
