In P.E children have continued to develop their tennis skills and we have started to practice for Sports Day next Friday.

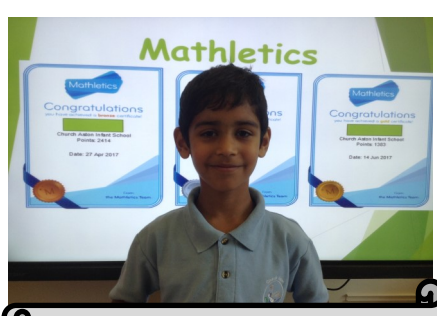
Class 2 were fabulous at finding litter during our Litter pick around Church Aston and were enthusiastic to become junior street champions.



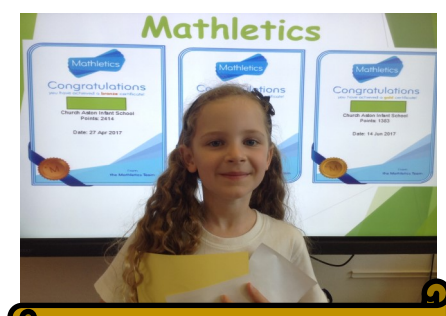
