We have had a lovely week in class 1 with lots of role play in our Dinosaur museum. The children have worn costumes to act out Mary Anning's life and 'hot seated' to ask and answer questions as Mary Anning or her father. We also compared how Mary Anning's discoveries were recorded compared to the four-year-old girl Lilly who discovered a dinosaur footprint in January 2021.

In maths, reception children have copied, continued, and created patterns using actions and all sorts of objects. Year 1s have learned that addition and subtraction are inverse operations and have used practical and pictorial representations

CLASS 2

It has been an exciting week in Class 2. Just yesterday Sapphire told me "I've had fun with my friends, interesting lessons and I have learned lots!" I thought this was a perfect way to describe our week.

In maths the year 2 children have been working relationships between the ten and the five times tables and using this to help solve problems. In year 1 the children have explored multiples of ten, adding and subtracting them, and using our number facts to ten to support this. For example, if I know 3+6=9 then I know 30+60=90.

In English we are working on writing statements in a non-fiction report about Mary Anning sharing the facts that we have learned. Our class target is to use a capital letter and full stop in each complete sentence, and we have discussed each new sentence as a new idea.

For Art and DT this week Class 2 have been busy learning more about dinosaurs. On Tuesday afternoon, we made Pterodactyl Peg Puppets and Geometry Dinosaurs. We created different dinosaurs out of 2D shapes and made a picture out of them. On Thursday afternoon, we made Ichthyosaurus Pasta Fossils as part of our work on Mary Anning.



Some of our children have been sharing in a special week for them and their families. Making unleavened bread has been part of this. It looks wonderful.








