In English the children have written recounts about their Easter holidays. Year one children blew me away with their use of time connectives to make their writing more interesting!

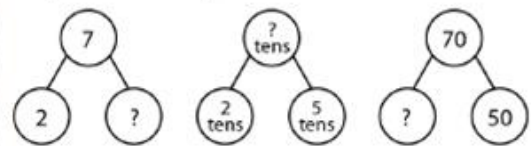
We have also made super posters all about the three R's.

It was wonderful to see all the children's smiling faces full of news from their break.

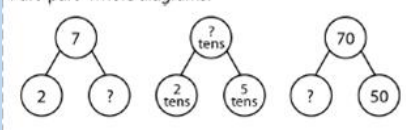
We have started this term celebrating Earth Day. Our topic is Planet Earth and Earth Day has given us a great opportunity to think about we can look after our world.

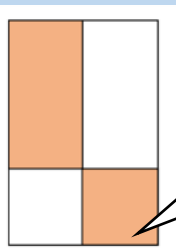
Our text is Dear Greenpeace by Simon James and the children have found it interesting that the story is told through letters.
