
HIGHLIGHTS

The national news caught our attention this week when a giant pet lizard called Echo escaped from her owner's garden in Workington! We decided to




In Year 2 maths we have been investigating mass. The children have used balance scales to explore what is heavier, lighter and equal to around the classroom.
