It is great to see the children coming into school happily and settled in their new classes. There is quite a buzz of learning around the school as the children are eagerly getting on with their tasks.


Reception children are getting used to the idea of team tokens and there was a lot of anticipation this week to find out which was the first winning team of the year.




Reception have started their phonics journey this week and have already learned 5 sounds! These are m, a, s, d and t. They have loved meeting Fred the Frog who can say and read words only in pure sounds. He will be part of all our phonics lessons.

Year One have continued their phonics learning and are reading so well, even after 6 whole weeks off!

In maths Reception met our friend Maths Mouse who loves hearing the children count! We learned a big word in our maths lessons this week...subitising! Ask your children what this means, they are all very good at it! Year 1's have been comparing length and weight and counting accurately to 10.





Our focus text this week has been The Colour Monster Goes to School which the children have loved! On Monday we had a special delivery...a box full of colour monsters! We have talked and written about our feelings this week, focussing on how we felt starting or coming back to school, just like the Colour Monster in the book.

In our art lessons this half term we will be focussing on our drawing techniques and will complete self portraits.

MATHLETICS INFORMATION

You will see in the front of your child's reading diary there is a password for our Maths online programme for home learning. This is called Mathletics and can be done daily to build up points to gain a certificate that will be awarded on a Friday in our celebration Assembly. The cut off for the week to gain points is Thursday night. It is a fun and interactive way to learn Maths.

Earn 1000 points per week to receive a bronze certificate, after 5 bronze you will receive a silver certificate. This process is then repeated until you have gained 4 silver certificates you will then be awarded for your hard work with a gold certificate.
