In phonics this week Reception learned the sounds oo (look in the book), ar (start the car), or (shut the door), air (that's not fair) and ir (whirl and twirl).




Reception have ordering to 5 and making staircases by adding one more to our towers.






## CLASS 2

it was cruel to put the dog in the machine that spun ran so fast.




The year 2 children have been very busy working on their strategies for adding two-digit numbers. They children have recapped partitioning the tens and units, adding the tens in one big jump, and then using their

In year 1 we have mastered how to use the part, part whole models and bar models to help us find a missing number in subtraction. Another fantastic week, week done!







