

It has been a busy week in Class 2! The children are thoroughly involved to our new topic 'Dinosaurs'. The children have been writing a diary in the first person, sharing a day in the

life of Mary Anning. In history the children have sequenced the key events in Mary's life and we found out that she discovered the first lchthyosaurus.



When she was 12, her brother Joseph found a strange-looking fossilised skull. Mary dug out the outline of its 5.2-metre-long skeleton! At the time, scientists thought it was a crocodile! Years later it was named Ichthyosaurus which we now know is a marine reptile that lived 201-194 million years ago.

In science we have observed what has happened with our seeds. The children were very excited because many of the seeds have started to grow a root and/or a shoot. The year 1 children explored the differences between deciduous and evergreen trees and year 2 have looked at the difference between a seed and a bulb.


