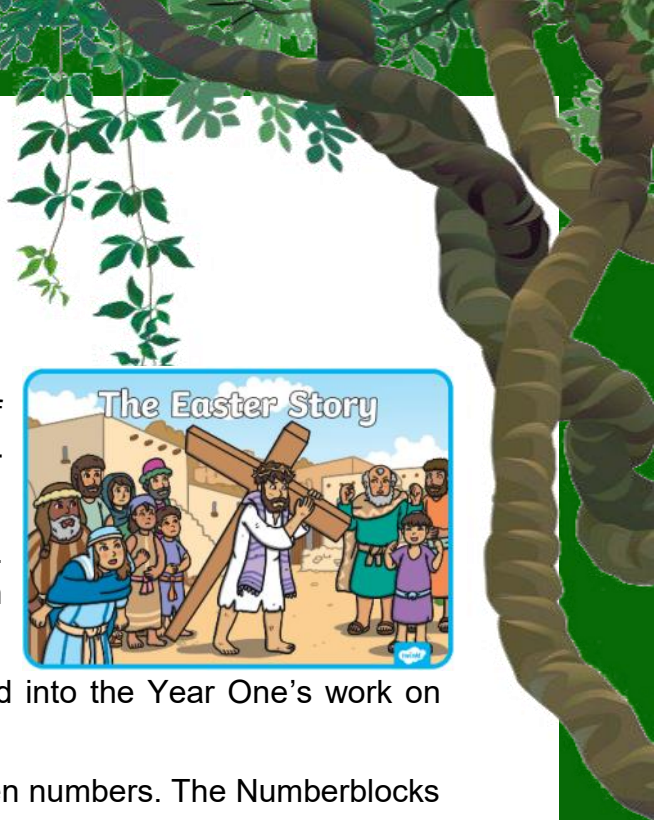

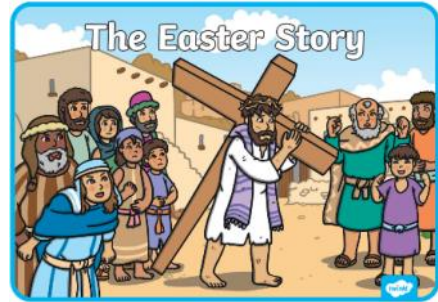


# CLASS 1

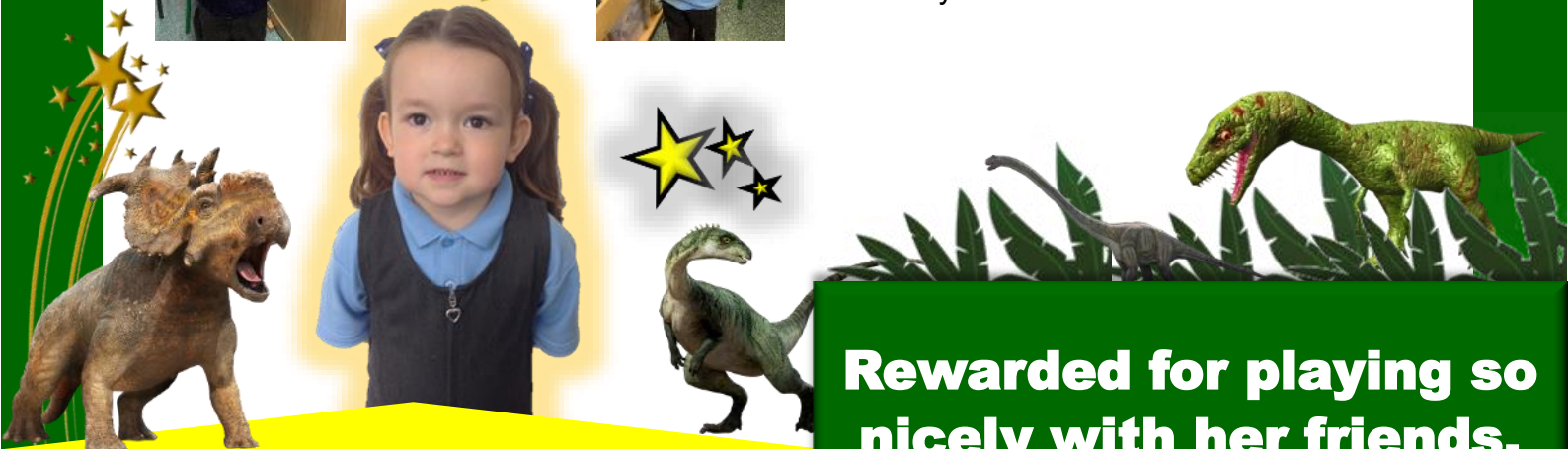
The Year One's have just started to look at counting in tens. We've considered why it is useful to count in tens rather than ones and

Have a fantastic Easter break and we will see you back in school on the 8<sup>th</sup>!

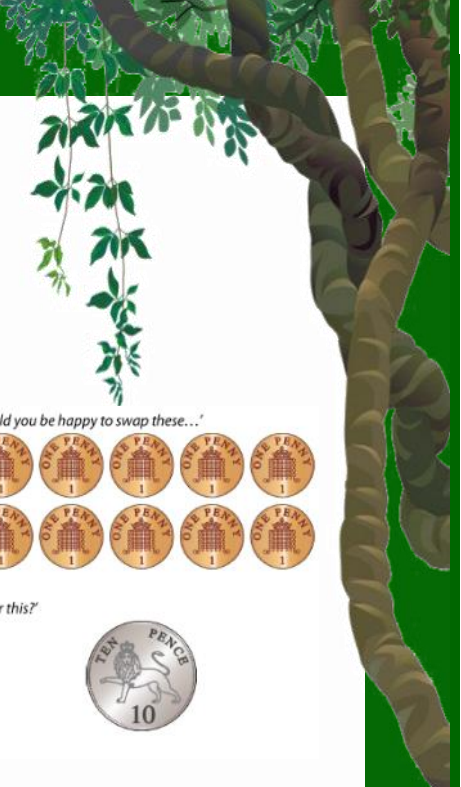

# CLASS 2



It has been a whirlwind term! We've been searching for fossils, following the life of Mary Anning and learning to write non-fiction reports. The children have enjoyed putting their new facts into reports in their book.

In maths the year one children have just started to look at counting in tens. We've considered why it is useful to count in tens rather than ones and whether we would swap 10p for 10 1p coins. Would you swap?

Would you be happy to swap these...?

$$5 \times 10 = 50 \quad \text{so} \quad 5 \times 9 = \square$$

$$14 \times 5 = 70 \quad \text{so} \quad 13 \times 5 = \square$$

$$17 \times 5 = 85 \quad \text{so} \quad 18 \times 5 = \square$$

$$5 \times 4 = 5 \times 3 + \square$$
$$5 \times 4 - 5 = \square \times \square$$

In year two maths the children are continuing to secure their multiplication skills with the five, and ten times table. They will be looking for links between the tables and exploring what we can find out by knowing our facts off by heart.

In science we have been excited to see our seeds growing. By having the seeds growing in a bag without soil it has given the children the

opportunity to see the roots and shoots growing. Now we are at the end of the Spring Term the children have grown in height and knowledge just like their seeds!

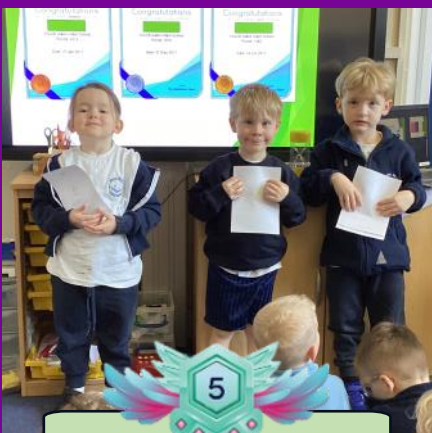
