What an exciting week we have had with the unexpected arrival of snow! The children had a wonderful snow party on Wednesday morning playing in the fresh layer that we had that morning. Have a look at the photos below.

Class 1 had a surprising visitor this week in the form of Dotty the Dragon who crash landed at the front of school. She has generated lots of excitement and curiosity. As a result, the children are writing lots about her.

Class 2 have been exploring materials this week. They have been investigating what different items around school are made from. They have made links back to our visit to Stafford Castle and designed their own castles using suitable materials. As you can see below, they are using a wide range of vocabulary to describe different materials and their properties.

On Monday in assembly we discussed bullying, how to recognise it and what to do The children were good at understanding what behaviours might be experienced and what to do about it. We talked about bullying was a repetitive event rather than a one off. Mrs Powell continued this discussion on Wednesday in assembly making links to keeping safe online.
