UPDATES FROM THE CLASSES

The Great Bug Hunt 2019

On Monday Year 4 took part in The Great Bug Hunt 2019. Each class went to a different habitat around school. 4S1 went to the wild area and 4S2 went to the orchard. The children were separated into groups so that they could survey the living things within the habitat and make notes about how many of each living thing they saw and any specific information about where in the habitat they were. Once the children had collected this information they then used this to collate a whole class record of the habitat and the living things within it. This information was then used to create a bar chart that the children could then draw conclusions from about the habitat.

Following this the children took as inspiration the work of Charles Darwin and his studies of the living things he encountered on his voyages of exploration. The children drew various living things from different perspectives to show them in as much detail as possible.



On Thursday 6th June Year 4 went on a trip to High Ercall church to learn about Pentecost. Firstly, a lady told us what Pentecost was. She told us that Pentecost was when the Holy Spirit came. Then we had some different activities to do. One of the stations was about telling good news and we got to lights a candle because it shows the light of the world. The station after that was where we had to act out helping someone poor. Then we wrote on a paper foot asking to have help helping someone by having the courage

to do it. The third station was where we wrote a prayer on a perer flag asking for help with something. On the fourth station called sharing we learnt all about not wasting, helping, sharing food and more. We put people on a cardboard church to show a church of people. Another one was where we wrote on a dove about trying to do something. Then we went into another room and learnt about being a Christian in other countries where it can be very difficult. Finally, we had biscuits and juice and then went back to school bursting with things to tell our parents.
