Common exception spelling words for year 1

Here is the list of spellings that we would like all year 1 children to spell correctly by the end of the summer term. As we are a third of the way through the year we would like to see which words we need to focus on because children are finding them tricky. Your spelling focus this week will be on the top six lines of the square. Choose at least 8 words you would like to practise daily and then check these on Monday next week.

Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check

Get your child to look at the word and say it out loud, then cover it, write it and check to see if it is correct. If not, highlight or underline the incorrect part and repeat the process.

<u>Syllables</u>

Break the word down into its syllables. Say or clap each syllable in the word as they write the word down.

Speed Writing

See how many times your child can write the word correctly in one minute. Repeat with the other words from the spelling list.
